Professional Truck Driver Training Program

The Professional Truck Driver Training program is a comprehensive program designed to teach students to master the skills for the entry-level tractor-trailer driver; that is, the minimum training requirement to become a CDL driver. In addition, training for Hazmat, Tankers, Doubles and Triples, and Passenger endorsements are offered.

- **Training location:** Main Campus only (4005 Campus Drive, Fort Worth)
- **Duration of the course:** 200 hours/7 weeks (approximately)
- **Prerequisites:** High school diploma or G.E.D. certificate,
TABE Test results: 7th grade-Math, 7th grade-Reading and 7th grade-Language
- **Screening:** Drug screenings and background checks will be performed.
- **Training hours:** Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 3:20 p.m.
- **Enrollment:** Now enrolling!
